Reports:

McTeacher Night Reminder: Sheri Hutchinson reminded all of our McTeacher night tonight. 5pm-8pm. School receives 20% on all sales including drive through during that time. We also gain \$.60 profit on each cookie sold for \$1.00. Teachers be sure to push those cookies.

Box Top and Kohl's revenue: Kristin McPherson reported on recent revenue received. We received our check for fall Box tops, over \$600 raised. We also received a check for our Kohl's volunteers at Bingo Night for \$500.00 We will be using Kohl's again on Spaghetti night and Field day. Kristin will see if we can schedule them to help with Chocolate Bunny fundraiser.

Labels for education: Kristin McPherson provided information on bonus forms found in weekly ads. Example shared with all. Please look for these in your Tuesday mailers and Sunday papers. Send any extra forms into Boosters and we will fill them up with labels if you don't have any.

Scrip Update: Taryn Rhodes give an update on the program and provided dates for next order/delivery dates. She has updated the booster website with future order/delivery schedules and the form to order. Sarah still has a few gift cards remaining from Bingo night if anyone is interested in buying them. Fundraiser Committee Update: Taryn Rhodes discusses ideas of wanting to kick this committee off in the next few weeks. Her goal is to gather feedback and input towards 2012-2013 fundraisers. She will work with those on the committee to establish a regular meeting time in the future.

Yearbook Committee Update: Shari Davis reported on status of the yearbook committee.

- All grades have been assigned a contact person from the yearbook team. Their role is to work with that grade level to gather pictures of all students from events throughout the year. Teachers if you have not been contacted yet, please let Shari know and she will follow up.
- Cover contest details have been finalized and will kick off on Friday, January 13th. Shari and Sally will visit all classrooms to give students information on the plans for a yearbook as well as details for the cover contest. Students have until the 30th of January to submit their design ideas. All designs will go on display in the art gallery Feb 6th-10th. Feb 6th- 9th Teachers and staff will vote to select the top 10 designs. Feb 10th the top 10 selected will be moved to the cafeteria and students will vote during their lunch break on the design that will be on the front of our yearbook. All other student designs not making the top 10 will be placed within the yearbook.
- Business ad revenue has been collected by Leo Eskola. Our goal was to raise \$600 to reduce the overall cost of the yearbook and Leo has done that already. We want to keep the business ads to just two pages in the book.
- Yearbook pre-sales will begin in February as we have to know the quantity needed prior to ordering the yearbooks. Initial estimates indicate that the cost of our yearbook will be roughly \$11.00.
- We decided to allow space for personal ads from parents to their 6th graders. Parents can purchase ad space for \$5. Per ad. Ad space will be approximately 30 words. More info to come in February about this.

Apparel Update: Shari Davis reported on current apparel available. There is a very small amount of apparel remaining from our fall sales. Most are small sizes. We will be discounting these items to get rid of them. Questions? Please see Shari
